

SECTION 4 : FIRST AID MEASURES

4.1	DESCRIPTION OF FIRST-AID MEASURES:
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Symptoms may occur after exposure, so that in case of direct exposure to the product, when in doubt, or when symptoms persist, seek medical attention. 8.1 CONTROL PARAMETERS:

EXPOSURE CONTROLS:**ENGINEERING MEASURES:**

Provide adequate ventilation. Where reasonably practicable, this should be achieved by the use of local exhaust ventilation and good general extraction. If these measures are not sufficient to maintain concentrations of particulates and vapours below the Occupational Exposure Limits, suitable respiratory protection must be worn.

Protection of respiratory system: Avoid the inhalation of vapours.

Protection of eyes and face: It is recommended to dispose of water taps or sources with clean water close to the working area.

Protection of hands and skin: It is recommended to dispose of water taps or sources with clean water close to the working area. Barrier creams may help to protect the exposed areas of the skin. Barrier creams should not be applied once exposure has occurred.

Mask:

AX-type filter mask (brown) for gases and vapours of organic compounds with a boiling point less or equal to 65°C (OSHA 29CFR 1910.134 and ANSI Z88.2), with single-use filters.
